

Landscaping Boulder Arrangements

Landscaping boulder arrangements in front yards require ACC prior approval. Guidelines for landscaping boulder arrangements are as follows:

- A landscaping boulder arrangement (1 - 3 boulders) must be placed in a centralized area that has ground cover such as mulch or other approved ground cover around it by at least 12 inches on all sides.
- Landscaping boulder arrangements can be comprised of 1 – 3 boulders, not to exceed the limitations below for any one boulder or group of boulders with respect to the size of the boulder or boulder grouping.
- The arrangement should not restrict front yard maintenance by our crews that maintain our front yards.
- The arrangement in totality can be no more than 3 feet in diameter at the widest point, no more than 6 feet at the longest point, and less than 2 feet high at the highest point.
- Boulder or boulder grouping must be at least 6 feet from the sidewalk.
- Only 1 boulder grouping/arrangement per yard.
- Boulders should be of natural stone formation with no artistic or design modifications. Boulders cannot be painted or have any manmade markings on them.
- Give consideration to the size of your yard when designing your boulder arrangement and the above requirements. Keep in mind the relationship to the rest of your yard.
